We all deserve to be treated fairly, no matter where we work.



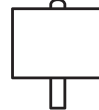
Like all workers, federal public service workers are feeling the pinch as costs rise. The majority of our members are women making between \$40-65k a year.

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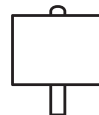
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
