Take Action – Treasury Board Directive on Hybrid Work

On May 1, the Treasury Board of Canada mandated that all federal public service employees must be at the physical work site a minimum of three days per week, starting in September. On May 14, USJE held info pickets at sites across Canada to further express our opposition to the mandate.

This generic policy continues to lack nuance in terms of an individual's work realities and ignores the widely used technological innovations already in place.

USJE is urging its members to immediately reach out to the President of the Treasury Board, Minister Anita Anand, to express their opposition to a 'one size fits all' approach.

USJE Rejects CSC's New Case Management Network

For many years now, the Union of Safety and Justice Employees has been insisting that the Correctional Service of Canada (CSC) undertake a comprehensive review of the Community Parole Officer Resourcing Formula (CPORF).

Despite USJE's best efforts to have a productive dialogue with CSC on the creation of a better funding formula, CSC insisted on pursuing a formula review that was too narrow in scope and didn't properly acknowledge the significant concerns of many Community Parole Officers.
