Union Safety Net Episode 13—3300 job cuts at Immigration department

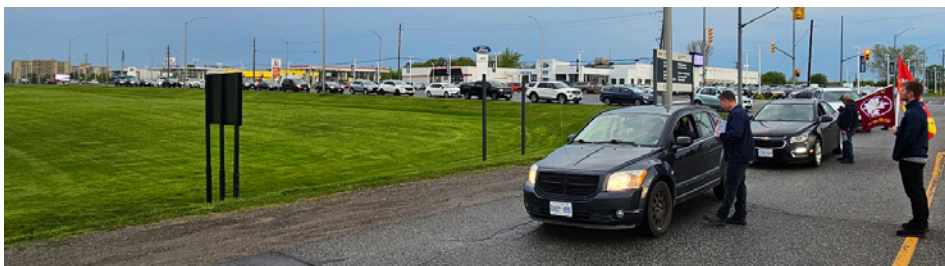
